# **Brown County 4-H Lego Robotics Rental Agreement**

### General:

- Kits can be rented jointly by a Brown County 4-H member taking the 4-H #507 Robotics Project, <u>and</u> their parent or guardian. Both the member and parent must sign this agreement.
- This project requires access to a personal computer on which you can access the internet and download software. Library connections are not suitable.
- Members agree to only use the approved, provided software and cords for programming their robot. No hacking or other modification of the software or hardware is permitted.
- Members are expected to <u>complete their project</u> by attending the scheduled county judging.
- If members rent a kit and do not complete judging, they are not eligible to rent a kit in the future.

#### Timeline:

- Kits can be reserved, on a first come, first served basis, any time after April 1<sup>st</sup> by returning this agreement (by mail or in person) with the deposit payment. They will not be reserved over the phone.
- Kits can be signed out no earlier than April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Kits are due back to OSU Extension <u>within one week</u> of the completion of Project Judging in Brown County. This project is judged at the September 4-H project judging. Members wishing to qualify for the state fair would need to attend both the July and September judging.

## Cost / Fees:

- The <u>replacement cost</u> of this kit is approximately \$435.
- The only up-front fee is a \$50 deposit. The entire deposit (\$50) will be returned upon completion of county judging and return of a 100% complete, fully functioning kit.
  - o Robots must be disassembled prior to return.
  - The brick and all motors must be in working order
  - All pieces must be returned to the correct compartment of the sorting trays.
- If members do not complete judging, \$30 will be refunded upon the return of a fully functioning kit. The remaining \$20 will be kept by the Extension Office as a non-completion fee.
- Members / Parents who do not return the kit on time will be invoiced \$435.
- Members / Parents who return kits with missing or broken parts will be responsible for the cost of replacing those parts, or the cost of replacing the kit, whichever is less. The \$50 deposit will be applied to those costs.

We have read the above agreement and agree to abide by all terms above, including the financial cost for replacing any missing, or broken parts up to the total cost of the kit (\$435). We hereby release from liability and agree to indemnify and hold harmless OSU Extension and Brown County 4-H and any of their employees, volunteers, or agents from any and all liability, loss, or damage that may be suffered or incurred in connection with the use or possession of the equipment. This release is for any and all personal liability for personal injuries (including death) and property losses or damage occasioned by, or in connection with the possession or use of this equipment.
