

## Brown County 4-H Residential Camp Scholarship Available

The Brown County 4-H Committee is offering \$125 scholarships to Brown County 4-H'ers to attend 2024 Brown County 4-H Camps. Camp scholarships are also supported by the Brown County Pork Producers in memory of Margaret Rosselot and the Harrison Scholarship Fund. Junior Shooting Sports Campers may also apply for scholarships using this process; scholarships will be for up to but not exceeding 75% of the cost of camp. **Jr. Shooting Sports Camp has an earlier deadline in 2024!**

**Who:** To be eligible applicants must be enrolled in the Brown County 4-H program. Campers must be 8 and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, to attend any of the residential camps.

**What:** \$125 scholarships to attend one of the Brown County affiliated 4-H Residential Camps. Camps are held at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, OH. This applies to Beginner, Junior High Camp, and Teen Camp. Scholarships may be available annually for additional camps, contact the Extension Office for more information. Dates of camps are listed annually on our website <http://brown.osu.edu/4hcamp>. Camps are based on the grade a camper is currently enrolled, please see registration materials to determine the correct camp.

**When: Scholarship Applications for residential camps are due by May 13, 2024, to the Extension Office. Scholarships for Jr. Shooting Sports Camp are due April 18th.** Applicants will be notified by email if they have been selected for a scholarship. Please see the website for the respective camp registration dates and fees. All registrations are first come, first served.

**How:** To apply for a scholarship submit a 250–400-word essay explaining why you want to attend 4-H camp and how you think it will benefit you. Please include your name, age, and 4-H club at the top of your essay. You may submit your essay one of two ways:

- Option 1 – submit a hardcopy written essay to the Extension office. Please include your name, age, and 4-H club at the top of your essay.
