

Brown County 4-H Residential Camp Scholarship Available

The Brown County 4-H Committee is offering \$100 scholarships to Brown County 4-H'ers to attend 2020 Brown County 4-H Camps. Camp scholarships are also supported by the Brown County Pork Producers in memory of Margaret Rosselot and the Harrison Scholarship Fund.

Who: To be eligible applicants must be enrolled in the Brown County 4-H program. Campers must be 8 and in the 3rd grade as of January 1st, 2020 to attend any of the residential camps.

What: \$100 scholarships to attend one of the Brown County affiliated 4-H Residential Camps. Camps are held at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, OH. Beginner Camp is June 1-4, Junior High Camp is June 11-14, and Teen Camp is June 22-25. Camps are based on the grade a camper is currently enrolled, please see registration materials to determine the correct camp.

When: Scholarship Applications are due by May 15, 2020 to the Extension Office. Applicants will be notified by email if they have been selected for a scholarship. The registration deadline is May 21st for Beginner and the total cost is \$147. The deadline for Junior High camp is June 1st and the total cost is \$147; Teen camp registration is June 15th and the total cost is \$151. All registrations are first come, first served and sell out quickly.

How: To apply for a scholarship submit your completed camp registration form; your portion of the payment (\$47 for beginner and junior high; \$51 for teen camp) and a 250-400 word essay explaining why you want to attend 4-H camp and how you think it will benefit you. Please include your name, age, and 4-H club at the top of your essay.
