Dog Achievement Program (DAP)

Dear Dog Achievement Project Member,

We are excited that you chose to register for a dog achievement program in 2023. This letter will provide you with dates, links, and information specific to the dog achievement program (DAP) for the 2023 project year. DAP Requirements

Project Helper

Identify a project helper that can work with you on your DAP project. This project helper will verify your completed activities and initial your DAP record pages.

Certificates

To complete the Dog Achievement Program project, a certificate must be earned by the county's project deadline, of Sept 30th, 2023. To complete a certificate, choose 3 topic areas within one category and complete all 5 activities within the topic area. If this is your first time taking a dog project (including the 201 or 202 Project) you must earn the *My Dog and Me* and the *Basic Training* certificates before earning additional certificates in any order. Members may earn duplicate certificates within any category if different topic areas are selected.

Lapel Pin

Members who complete certificate requirements for all 10 categories earn a Dog Achievement Program label pin. There are no time restrictions on completing all categories and can span over multiple project years.

DAP Registrations

July 15th Project Recognition Registration

After completing the requirements for a certificate, an online questionnaire must be completed by July 15, 2023, at <u>https://ohio4h.org/dapsummary</u>. A certificate of achievement will be mailed to you, and you will receive recognition at the Ohio State Fair Dog Show for the relevant year.
