

201 Dog Project and Record Book

Skill Level: All Levels

For county project COMPLETION members must complete either:

- Participate in the Brown County 4-H Dog Show at the fair
- Complete Skill-a-thon & Book Check
- Submit all Canine Paperwork by June 1st
- Advisor Grade
 - Completed by advisor by Sept. 15th; not eligible for exhibition or county awards

State Fair Qualification

- Submit required paperwork by State Fair Deadline
- Must pre-enter for classes online

Complete All of the following for completion:

- Project animal by required date
- Project goals
- Member Project Guide, Dog Care and Welfare, and Animal Records sections.
- Must complete skill-a-thon & project book check

What to bring to judging:

- Completed project book

County Fair Exhibit

- Participate in Dog Show

State Fair:

- Sign up by appropriate deadlines
- Event: See “Jr. Livestock” events under the competitions tab at ohiostatefair.com

Note: Members enrolled in multiple animal projects that require skill-a-thon & book check must complete at least one skill-a-thon & book check for a project they are enrolled to be eligible for exhibition of all their animal projects. They are encouraged to complete skill-a-thon & book checks for all projects they are enrolled.

- The exception for this is members in Beef, Sheep, & Swine, these members MUST complete skill-a-thon for each of those species to be eligible to exhibit.
- If your species offers an Outstanding Exhibitor Award you may be required to complete skill-a-thon & book checks to be eligible for awards in that category.
