Skill Level: Intermediate

For county project COMPLETION members must complete either:

- Participate in Cat Show Monday of fair
 - All posters accepted between 4:00 – 6:00pm Sunday of fair
 - Small Animal form with picture of you and your animal due to the Extension Office by September 1.
- Advisor Grade
 - Completed by advisor by September 15th. Youth would not exhibit at fair.

State Fair Qualification

- Participate in July Judging – State Fair Qualification Only. ALL projects must be brought back in September to be eligible for county awards.

Complete All of the following for completion:

- Cat-a-logue Your Knowledge evaluation, before and after project
- At least 7 activities each year
- At least 21 of the Purr-fect Pals and Feline adventures
- Complete Purr-fect Pals Achievement Program within three years

What to bring to judging/County Fair Exhibit:

- Picture of you and your cat must be turned into the Extension Office by September 1.
- Check fair book for health requirements
- Display Poster
- Completed Project Book
- Participate in Cat Show at fair and interview with a judge
- Cat Vaccine records must be brought to Cat Show

State Fair:

- Selected during county-level competition in July.
- Event: Companion Animal Day
