It will soon be time for the annual 4-H Shooting Sports Safety meetings. They are scheduled this year for Wednesday, May 3, 2023, <u>OR</u> Tuesday, May 16, 2023, in Rhonemus Hall at the Brown County Fairgrounds, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. You only need to attend one of the scheduled safety meetings. This will be the opportunity to complete all of the required paperwork, have a discussion with members and parents on the objectives of the shooting sports program, and convey the importance of all aspect of safety as it pertains to the program. It will be the first opportunity for many of the members and parents to meet the instructors.

Reminder...members taking a Shooting Sports project and a parent or legal guardian, <u>MUST</u> attend at least one of the safety meetings, and pay the \$15.00 fee, to participate in any of the range activities.

Youth enrolled in Basic Archery and/or Safe Use of Guns are NOT required to attend the Safety Meetings. You may attend as an Educational Activity for your project. These two projects are self-directed and DO NOT meet on the range with certified instructors.
