

Club Constitutions & By-Laws

Updated documents due by May 1st

- Ohio 4-H Clubs are required to use the Ohio 4-H Club Constitution Template it was revised for 2024.
 - ALL CLUBS must review and adopt this version.
- The Ohio 4-H By-Laws Template is optional but clubs should have by-laws. These should be reviewed by members annually.
- Club by-laws can be stricter than the Constitution and county policy but can not be less restrictive.
- Make sure to review the Brown County 4-H Policies & Guidelines.

Club Constitutions & By-Laws

Updated documents due by May 1st

 The Club will enroll at least 5 members from at least 3 families each year. At minimum, three of the five club youth must be at least 8 and enrolled in 3rd grade, or age 9 an above regardless of grade level for Parliamentary Procedures to be followed.

Skillathon & Project Books

- Project Record Books are an important part of the 4-H experience.
 All projects have a required book.
- Animal Project Members will be required to complete one project book record check.
- All animal projects will be required to complete one skillathon to be eligible to exhibit. If a junior fair department requires skillathon, you must complete any required skillathons to be eligible to exhibit. Ex. If you are taking beef and sheep, both require skillathon, you must take both.
- Skillathon & Project Book check dates will be announced soon.

DUNF

More important than ever to be accurate!

- Legal document
- If we see errors on addresses, tags, etc. we will send it back to be fixed.
 - We CANNOT edit these starting in 2024.
- If you make an error that is a disqualifiable error (ex. wrong route of medication; no QA; withdrawal time is incorrect) and the MEMBER does not correct it immediately before OSU/ODA reviews it, they will NOT be allowed to exhibit.
- Required to exhibit for certain species.

Jr. Fair Updates

What's Known as of Now

- No re-weighs of animals
- No family hogs youth can tag 3 barrows and 3 gilts; show 2 of each.
- Exhibitor must show own animal in class and showmanship.
 Exceptions to showing in class must be pre-approved for a valid reason.
 - If an exhibitor has multiple animals in a class, it is approved following the junior fair rules for exhibitors.
- Swine possession/ownership day of tag-in
- Upper weight for swine increase to 290
