

# Teen Leadership Opportunity: Buckeye Leadership Workshop

- What is BLW? This workshop is a leadership retreat for youth who are at least 15 (or a freshman) to adults. It is geared to those who are wanting to building their leadership and recreation skills. Everyone who attends is considered a teacher, and there are opportunities for a variety of lessons.

- When? March 25-29 at Recreation Unlimited in Ashley, Ohio.
- How much? The total cost of BLW if registered by February 20<sup>th</sup> is \$375.
  - Scholarships: BLW offers scholarship as does OSU Extension Brown County. This scholarship opportunity is different from the other awards. Limited scholarships are available.
- Who is eligible for a scholarship?
  - Any teen who is active in Junior Leaders or as a Camp Counselor for a scholarship may apply.
- How to apply:
  1. Contact Christy and let her know you are interested before December 15<sup>th</sup>.
  2. Apply to attend BLW and apply for the BLW scholarship.
    - a. This requires a \$100 deposit.
    - b. BLW Scholarships are due by January 6th
    - c. You MUST apply for the BLW scholarship, but you do not have to receive one to be eligible for county scholarships.
  3. Notify Christy of the status of your scholarship and if you receive one, for what amount. After BLW scholarships are announced, county scholarships will be determined.
    - a. Pending the number of applications for county scholarships, you should be responsible for no more than the \$100 deposit.
    - b. If you are a counselor for a residential camp and successfully complete all training and counsel at camp, you can be reimbursed up to \$55 of your total training costs from 4-H Committee. BLW would be a qualifying counselor training.
- ANY youth or adult is eligible to attend without a scholarship.
